Regarding the above Planning Application I wish to object to this being granted.

This is Green Belt land which should be protected at all costs.

There is no provision for the wild time in this plan, and undoubtedly will cause still more loss of habitat. Once built on it can not be returned to nature and will put more pressure on our wildlife.

The infrastructure of this area is not able to cope with still more traffic on Ashington Rd, and Brays Lane is only a country lane which is used by HGV lorries from Baltic Wharf and the large boat trailers from Wallasea Marina and Pagelsdown.

Doctors surgeries are fully booked, and the local

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schools plus dentist and shops are in short supply.

Travel to Southend Hospital is very often a night mare travelling along Ashington Rd.

After living here for over 50 yrs, I feel disappointed that a developer is trying to cash in on an area of countryside which we are privileged to enjoy.
