

Dear Ellie.

We have received a copy of ECC's letter of today's date and note there remains a holding objection which unfortunately is the only issue preventing the scheme from progressing to committee with a recommendation for approval. We would therefore seek to agree a way to resolve this matter this afternoon so that the Planning Officer can finalise the report today on this basis.

We note that ECC has raised concern about the FFLs for the scheme may suffer from inundation. Looking at Figure D 27 (ROC5) in South Essex Surface Water Management Plan, illustrates that there is only localised flooding shown on the site when subjected to a 1:100 year event. The depth of flooding is shown to be between 0.10m to 0.25m deep. We would therefore suggest that a condition is included in the consent which states that the FFLs shall be set no less than 300mm above the existing ground levels to prevent any floodwater inundation from the surface water source to mitigate this specific risk. Can you please confirm as a matter of urgency this is an acceptable proposal to ECC so that the holding objection can be removed please. If you can send an email direct to the Planning Officer (Ms Claire Buckley - Claire.Buckley@Rochford.gov.uk) this afternoon that would be very much appreciated.

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
