As the scheme operator, ELECSA takes every care in the process of vetting registered installers but the installer remains solely responsible for the quality and compliance of the work as an independent contractor. If you have doubts about the safety of your installation, this should be raised with the installing contractor in the first instance.

A requirement of all electrical competent persons schemes is that you should be given the opportunity to purchase an insurance backed warranty for additional peace of mind. Your installer should have provided you with information that would enable you to do so.

Your installer may have a facility with ECIC (Electrical Contractors' Insurance Company Limited) for provision of such a warranty.
