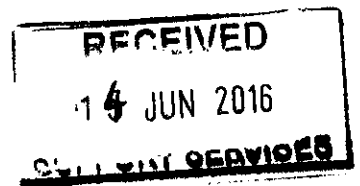
① Let the planning Application Dept use the same research they used on the same application last time.
