We object to this proposal for the following reason:

This proposal was originally for a residential home. When we originally purchased our home in 2014 we were informed of the intention to build holiday homes in the flood area with a boundary between the residential and holiday homes. The space behind number 87 and the base of the new plot is very minimal and in our opinion does not leave any room for a boundary.

We purchased our property as residential for people 50 plus. The holiday homes however have no age limit and a very different set of park rules. For Berkeley Homes to totally segregate residential and holiday homes they need to allow room for a boundary. Therefore the plot is not suitable for a holiday home.

We strongly feel that if this proposal goes ahead it will affect the peace and tranquillity of the residential home owners. We did not buy our home on a holiday site. As already stated, we knew of the intention to build holiday homes but totally segregated and with boundaries which if this proposal goes ahead there will not be.
