Excavations: Contractors must ensure that they have full information relating to service and drainage positions before undertaking any excavations.
Root barriers to be used in association with tree planting adjacent to kerbs / services / footpaths etc. (GreenBlue Urban Root products or similar application, in accordance with manufacturer's instructions).
