I think we need to condition a tree protection plan and method statement in accordance with BS 5837, this should include protection of the roots during installation of services, any required founds, etc, – this is to ensure that the proposal does not impact upon the health of the trees. Marylands Wood is subject to a woodland tree preservation order. Furthermore we will need details of any pruning required to maintain the tree from the flat roof to provide sufficient crown clearance, etc.
