




I would also argue that the requirement for infiltration testing could be conditioned as part of a planning application. Infiltration could be determined once the drainage strategy has been approved - and could result in some of our attenuation features and permeable paved areas being unlined to allow for passive infiltration. I would argue that infiltration should not be used as the sole method of surface water disposal as British Geological Survey information shows the site to be underlain by clay and silt.

All other items Nikki I will be able to get to you next week - including the half drain times, and exceedance routes.
