Dear Katie and Richard,

I have reviewed the attached technical note from the applicant's acoustic consultant.

I am satisfied that all the points that I wished to be considered/clarified have now been. As such, I see no reason why this application should not proceed, subject to inclusion of a condition requiring the installation of the approved equipment and noise attenuation detailed in the acoustic report and technical note. Such equipment and mitigation should be maintained in perpetuity. The visual elements of the scheme should be included.

Should Members retain any concerns beyond this, they may wish to consider whether it is appropriate to also include a condition requiring a post-implementation noise survey (which would also include a route to remedy should the expected noise environment not be achieved). To be clear, I am not recommending this but present it as an option.

In light of the uncertainties in the acoustic report (ref: HA/AE500/v1.1 September 2022) a specific detailed

assessment and mitigation scheme for all plant, but particularly the plant serving Domino's, is needed. This report is to prioritise the protection of residents in Meadow Way when using their gardens and habitable rooms. The assessment will need to reference to BS8233:2014 and WHO guidance levels.

Vibration effects should also be considered and mitigated accordingly.

The applicant is advised to refer to the relevant planning permission for the Domino's store as there is an impact on the conditions imposed for that development in respect of operation and maintenance of plant in the approved form in perpetuity.

There is no reference to noise impacts from store stock deliveries and waste collections. These activities will need to be considered in a more complete, contemporaneous acoustic assessment of the proposed development.

Potential impacts of voices and other residential activities from the flats

(particularly in respect of the entrance façade) have not been assessed.

In summary, the acoustic report requires further work before officers can reflect on the suitability of the proposed development in respect of noise impacts and therefore would not endorse the granting of planning permission at this time. It would not be possible to apply robust and meaningful noise conditions to any permission, therefore none have been offered at this time.
