

Did you mean condition no.16 re widening and surfacing Footpath 57 Rawreth? I haven't been contacted about this by either Mark or the applicant in so far as I can see.

I have copied in Roy who is the area PROW Officer as there's a very slim chance that he might have been contacted by the developer directly.

What might of happened is either the develop has jumped the gun, or if they have been dealing with other adopted highway within their site they may have gone direct to Essex Highways Development Management (DM) team's clerk of works for approval, though I would have expected the DM officer to come to either PROW&Planning or Roy to check it was okay if that was the case.

DM's reference for the site appears to be 'DM/289/38 - Land North of London Road West off Rawreth Industrial Estate, Rawreth Lane, Rayleigh' but the information that I could find in their folders didn't show which officer is responsible for the site.

It would probably we prudent to ask the developer who they sought approval from (assuming they have).

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
Hi Rob,

Details have been submitted and are attached, see in particular plan 3 and plan 4.


